COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

Revised for Phase 2, May 19, 2020

- We are strictly following the orders of the BC Provincial Health Officer, and guidance from the BC Centre for Disease Control, WorksafeBC, Vancouver Coastal Health, and the City of Vancouver.
- In an abundance of caution, we will not be opening indoor seating in Phase 2. Outdoor tables are sanitized hourly, and there are disposable (COVID-19 approved) table wipes to take your own personal measures. Hand sanitizer is readily available, as are disposable mini towelette packets (these contain a cleansing agent, but are *not* sanitizer).
- While our capacity for people inside by square metre is 12, and by 50% ratio is 9, we prefer that **no more than 5 customers are inside at one time**. Parties should stay together (or send one inside), at the points indicated by signage, and stay two metres from others and staff at all times. If you are waiting for an order to be prepared, you are welcome to pick up at the take-away window. You can also pre-order online.
- Please tap if you can, but cash is also accepted.
- Please don't block the doorway, and give six feet to pedestrians at all times.
- We are sanitizing surfaces like crazy, but please take your own precautions.
- Wash your hands — you are welcome to use the bathroom (no purchase required).
- Staff are following a detailed COVID-19 personal safety plan, including protocols like monitoring for any symptoms, and we expect our customers to be doing the same.
- While we await an announcement from Dr. Bonnie Henry () on the preferred contact tracing app for BC, you can register your visit here with us if practicable (see poster).
